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# THIRD-PARTY ADMINISTRATOR BENCHMARKING RESULTS FOR 2022

During 2022, Sherlock Company conducted a benchmarking study of Third-Party Administrators. The combined membership served by these eight organizations was 3.8 million members, and the membership included Medical, Dental, Vision, FSA Administration and Pharmacy. The data surveyed was 2021 calendar year results.

These administrators are considerably lower cost than health insurers in more or less comparable products. Median medical product costs were \$18.64 PMPM versus \$29.55 for Blue Cross Blue Shield ASO/ASC arrangements, and \$24.91 for Independent/Provider-Sponsored ASO products. Interestingly, several of the TPAs included in this study are sister organizations to health insurers included in other *Sherlock Benchmarks* universes.

Part of this is structural, stemming from the markets served by TPAs. For instance, unlike insurers, TPAs do not serve individual members and the overall infrastructure reflects this. As a result, Sales and Marketing expenses were far lower.

Also, the product design tended to be different. Medical and Provider Management, typically a core service for insurers, is generally viewed as a supplemental service for TPAs. While that cluster of functions is not the largest, for the TPAs, these functions are excluded from the TPA values above.

The execution of Account Membership and Administration activities is key to understanding differences in execution. For instance, the mean auto-adjudication rate for the TPA's was 68.4% compared with 84.1% for IPS plans and 86.6% for Blue Plans. Accordingly claims staffing ratios for Blue and IPS plans were 62% and 82% of TPA levels. Information systems staffing ratios were 62% and 52% greater, respectively.
